

Rules and Regulations

1. There will be two age groups for the Kids Que hamburger competition, **Ages 6-10** and **Ages 11-15**.
 - Each participant will receive 1 Pound of "Sugarfire Top Secret Burger Blend" courtesy of Sugarfire Smokehouse to prepare for the judges.
 - Each participant will receive a Styrofoam clamshell box in which to submit their entry.
 - There are NO garnish rules inside the turn-in box, so SLBS garnish rules do not apply.
2. A parent or guardian **MUST** be present with the child during the entire cooking process to assist with the fire and sharp knives, this person will be the **only** assistant allowed in the cooking area. The assistant can bring a chair to sit and relax while their child cooks. Any other adults will be allowed outside the Kids Que cooking area to watch the competition, and cheer on all the Kids Que participants.
3. Please bring a table for a workspace for your child. This is important as the child will need to build their turn-in box inside the cooking area.
4. Slicing the entry into 6 portions will not be required. The judges will have knives to slice the entry after appearance has been judged.
5. The entries will be judged on Appearance, Taste, and Tenderness.
6. The SLBS scoring system will be used with 9 being the highest and 1 being the lowest.

Special Instructions

1. The Kids Que will take place on the basketball court located adjacent to the NW lot. The entry to the Kids Que area will be located between spots 188 and 189 on your BBQ Bash Map.
2. All Kids Que participants must be sponsored by a 2018 Wildwood BBQ Bash contest team.
3. NO alcohol or tobacco will be allowed in the contest area.
4. Check-in will begin promptly at 3:00 PM and the Cooks Meeting will begin at 3:15 PM.
5. Please bring all your utensils, seasonings, marinades, garnishes, etc. with you to Check-in. Please have food service gloves for the kids to use while handling the food.
6. The lids on the grills can get hot, so remember to bring oven pads or hot gloves to handle the lids and any hot food.
7. Participants will receive their numbered Styrofoam box at Check-in.
8. The weather may be hot, so please bring something for the kids and their assistants to drink to stay hydrated.
9. The ground beef is provided for your child, but no other garnish is provided.
10. If you have a child with special needs who may require additional assistance, please make a note of that on the entry form so that we may have everything available for your child.

Preparation

1. The child must do the preparation, cooking, and presentation of their entry. If the child is unable to complete these tasks, then we ask you to hold off for a future Kid's Que event when they are ready.
2. The adult supervisor/assistant may help with the fire for both age groups, and handling sharp knives for the 6-10 year old age group. We do not want anyone disqualified from the event, so please let your child compete in the contest and only assist with the tasks outlined above.
3. The turn in is a long walk from the cooking site, so we will have Kids Que signs made up for each assistant to carry notifying the public while you walk with your child to turn-in.
